

From Belfast

Travel time only 30 minutes from the Westlink

From Belfast head south via the M1 motorway following the signs for Sprucefield and Dublin.

At the Sprucefield roundabout (McDonalds) take the exit for Newry / Dublin, heading south you will pass Hillsborough, Dromore and Banbridge **keep to the speed limits** as there are a number of speed traps on this road.

Passing Banbridge you will see the Outlet Stores on your left, the range is only about 6 miles from here, you will then pass Loughbrickland (a lake / pond) also on your left and only a couple of miles from the range.

About a mile further on and on your right side you will pass the Travellers Kitchen which is a truckers cafe, usually there would be a number of container lorry's parked on the hard shoulder.

Next you will see a sign for Cedar Haven B & B (brown tourist sign) a couple of hundred yards past this sign you will be turning left, there is a sign "Donaghmore 1.5 miles" take this exit for Donaghmore, you should be on the Buskhill Road and the ranges are on your left, you can't miss the earth mounds and range wall on your left. Please drive past the range, just over 100 yards and directly in front of you, you will see a grey building, turn left and drive in to the car park in front of the Orange Lodge.

The ranges are open from 10am to 6pm each Saturday.

If you use Sat Nav. the post code for the Buskhill Road is BT34 1SD.
